

My Mosler Biography:

<u>Roger Bligan</u> – In 1970, Al Ryan hired me as a mechanic to service bank vault products and locks. In 1971 when the bank act went into effect, I started installing electronic security consisting of alarms and cameras; in 1973 went into a service territory working on alarms and cameras. From 1978 until 1983, I serviced RTS and ran an RTS territory; at that time we starting servicing all products in our territories.

From 1989 to 1999, I went into installation working on all product lines. Don Robinson, area tech specialist for the Central Area, was retiring, and I became the area tech specialist for the Central Area along with Gary Jenson. In 2000, I moved to the Great Lake Area as area tech specialist for the Great Lake Area along with Eric Benson. I was managing the alarm and camera replacement for the Old Kent- 5/3 Project in 2001; 5/3 had just bought Old Kent and wanted all the Old Kent locations brought up to 5/3 standards. I was doing this when Mosler closed their doors.

After Mosler, I worked for ADT for about a year, then worked for Montech out of California until December of 2003. In February 2004, I started with Diebold as an Installer and am still there. My hope is to retire in 2015.
