

My Mosler Biography:

<u>Dave Ranger</u> – I started with the Mosler Safe Company in October 1961, working for Wes Brinkman in Office Services. After approximately nine months, I moved to the Repair and Service Department working for Lon Ely at the Laurel Avenue plant and at Belle Avenue. I trained as a Bank Vault Inspector with Frank Taphorn and ran service calls out of Belle Avenue.

In 1963-64 I was recruited by Jack Smith to establish a resident bank vault inspection area in Fort Wayne, IN. The Fort Wayne area developed into a full service branch, and I was the Branch Manager there for several years.

In 1977 I was promoted to Central Region Service Manager in Chicago. In 1981, after a field reorganization, I was transferred to Boston as the North Region Installation and Service Manager.

After another field reorganization in 1983, I was transferred to Harrisburg, PA as the Branch Manager. Shortly thereafter, I was promoted to Regional Sales, Installation and Service Manager for the Baltimore – Washington area.

My next position was in Philadelphia and Harrisburg as Sales, Installation and Service Manager. I spent my last few years with Mosler as Service Center Manager for Philadelphia and Harrisburg.

After Mosler ceased operations, I worked for ADT, Diebold and Red Hawk until my retirement in 2011.
