

My Mosler Biography:

<u>Don Robinson</u> - I was working for Federal Electric Corp. the service division for IIT companies when Airmatics designed and built the first Autobanker for Mosler.

It was installed at FNB Waukesha WI. I was in Wisconsin at the time, and assisted in the installation and service of this product. When Mosler acquired Airmatics, they hired the field service personnel maintaining the new Mosler systems.

I reported to Bill Toepfer at the Milwaukee office.

During my time in Tech Services I provided support and training on AB, MIS410, Comsec, Invisicom and Computer based systems.
