

My Mosler Biography:

<u>Jerry Casey</u> - I joined the Mosler Boston Massachusetts operation in 1953 as a Sales/ Service Representative. I was hired by Arthur Anderson.

In 1958 I was interviewed and hired by A. Dee Grover as his Administrative Assistant and relocated to Hamilton, Ohio. I worked closely with the Hamilton and Covington, KY (original lock company) manufacturing plants, and communicated with field personnel during the early formation of a national service organization.

In 1961 I Transferred to Washington, DC as a District Service Manager reporting to A. Dee Grover.

In 1970 I was promoted to Area Manager-NY and relocated to Long Island, New York.

In 1980 I became Vice President of Marketing – Systems Division in Wayne, NJ reporting to Frank Murray. I was responsible for the consolidation and integration of the Wayne (ASD) and Danbury (ESD) operations into a single Electronic Systems Division.
