

My Mosler Biography:

Jim Parrock – After returning from the U.S. Navy in 1955, I was hired by George Fightmaster as a draftsman at the Mosler Lock Co. in Covington, KY. I left in 1957 to work at R.A. Jones Co. but was contacted by Tony Potzik and asked to rejoin Mosler. When Fred Huber relocated the Lock Co. to Milford, Ohio, I moved my family to Milford. Management changes occurred and I reported to Bob Lasley in Hamilton, though I remained in Milford as Manager of Lock Engineering.

The Milford Plant was expanded to include Data Retrieval Systems, Lou Mustain Replaced Fred Huber and Bob Lasley had Lock Engineering report to Lou.
