

My My Mosler Biography:

<u>Larry Greer</u> – I joined Mosler on April 1st, 1969, as an alarm technician. Hired by Dave Coleman in the Dallas Branch, I worked for Charlie East along with 3 others. The balance of the Dallas office consisted of Harold Lewis and an RTS tech, Don Boyne and Mike Doyle, vault techs.
