

My Mosler Biography:

<u>Paul Schnitker</u> - I joined Mosler in June 1965. Hired by Jack Smith, I worked as a Service Technician at Belle Avenue for Lon Ely and Doug Miller. Transferred to the Indianapolis Branch, I worked for Al Ryan as a Service Supervisor, and Assistant BISM. In 1970, I was promoted to Consolidated BISM for Indianapolis and Fort Wayne, Indiana.

In 1974 I transferred to Cincinnati as Project Installation Manager for the Ohio Regional Office and worked for Doug Miller. Later I became BISM of the Cincinnati Branch working Ron Barnett, Mid Atlantic regional Manager.
