

My Mosler Biography:

Jerry Floyd - I joined Mosler in 1974 as a pneumatic systems installer. I was hired by Dennis Wright in the Atlanta office and installed drive –in systems throughout Georgia, N. Carolina, South Carolina and Florida.

In 1975 I transferred to the Miami Florida office and worked as a service technician in Broward County and Dade County offices. In 1978 I transferred to the Tampa office and serviced a large area of northern Florida. In 1980 I transferred to the Tampa area as Service Supervisor. In 1981 I was moved to Regional Tech Nils Pearson was my supervisor.

In 1983 I transferred to the Baltimore office as Branch Manager. During that time I signed the largest Service Agreement of approximately \$450,000.00.

In 1987 I transferred to Hamilton Ohio to the International Division as Project Engineer for a \$12MM alarm and closed circuit system for Saudi Arabia.
