

**My Mosler Biography:**

**Nils Olaf Pearson** - Following a U.S. Navy enlistment during the Korean War, I was hired by Arthur F. "Andy" Anderson at Mosler's Boston office on June 1st, 1953 as a service department trainee. After a year of shop repair experience, I began traveling New England states, opening, repairing, servicing and installing security products and alarm systems. In 1961, I was assigned to assisting the Branch Service Manager, Fred Welch.

In 1963, I moved to Miami, FL to open Mosler's first Florida Branch.

1964 to Pittsburgh, PA as Branch Service and Installation Manager.
