

My Mosler Biography:

Peggy Scherrer Escapa Robinson – My employment with Mosler began at Plant #3 (Belle Ave) in 1966 in the Service Parts Dept. Under Gene Gabbard. National Service was then headed by Dee Grover and Jack Smith. I still remember being interviewed by Jack Smith. After Gene left Mosler I reported to Ray Click.

In 1982 I moved to Plant #1 (Grand Blvd.) Commercial Division reporting to Ron Troutman as Product Line Administrator.

Another move in 1982 took me to the Haeckel Bldg. on Route 4 in Fairfield, to the International Division as Supervisor, Orders and Shipping. The International Division then relocated to Plant #1. I worked with Floreal Lavin and reported to Art Lewis, VP International.

I left Mosler in 1988 after 22 years, when Fisher Body closed and my husband transferred to a GM facility in Michigan.

I returned to Hamilton and Mosler in 1999 as a Senior Buyer under Mike Hopkins, VP Operations in the Berk Blvd building. I remained there until Mosler closed in August 2001.

I was one of the Mosler employees hired by ADT and that ended 9 months later. I worked at the Butler County Board of Elections as the Finance Manager/ HR Rep for a little over 10 years and retired in November 2013.
