

My Mosler Biography:

Wayne Mays – I joined Mosler in 1973 as a service technician in the Baltimore, MD office reporting to Herman Wood. In the spring of 1974 we were transferred to a resident tech position in Salisbury, MD... Now that was a great job ... covering the Delmarva Peninsula.
